ABCs OF VOCAL HEALTH

Target Audience: 8th-12th Grade | Estimated Length: 45 min

The Indianapolis Opera Resident Artists are teaming up with Dr. Noah Parker from the IU Voice Center to bring you an engaging overview of the basics of vocal health! We'll take you behind the scenes of the art of singing to teach you about the anatomy and physiology responsible for the human voice. What do vocal folds actually look like? We'll discuss vocal production and resonance to show you how our unique voices are created, and we'll demonstrate different registers and voice types. What makes men sound different than women, and why are some voices light and bright and others deep and full? The artists will demonstrate different styles of singing, like jazz and musical theatre, because it's always possible to sing healthily, no matter what you're singing! Finally, we'll discuss some healthy practices to keep in mind, so you can keep your voice in tip top shape, and you know who to talk to, should you have a vocal issue.
