We'll discuss vocal production and resonance to show how speaking and singing voices are created, and we'll demonstrate different registers and voice types. The Indianapolis Opera Resident Artists will perform in different singing styles, like jazz and musical theatre, to show how it's always possible to sing healthily, no matter what you're singing! We'll discuss healthy vocal practices, so you too can keep your voice in tip-top shape and will know who to talk to, should you ever have a vocal issue.
